White Wine

- Gewürztraminer, Hugel, Alsace, France, 2006** 29.95
This wine is luscious and intense, tasting complex and of fragrant herbs, releasing wonderful aromas of lychees and peaches. We think it's really impressive.
- La Val Albariño, Rias Baixas, Spain, 2007** 28.95
A wonderfully fragrant wine from north-west Spain using the local Albariño grape. A slight spritz on the tongue characterizes this dry white and ensures its freshness. On the palate it is very elegant and delicate with hints of peaches, apricots and limes.
- Matua Valley, Sauvignon Blanc, Hawkes Bay, New Zealand, 2007** 32.95
A classic example of New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc, showing lively, zingy, zesty fruit with flavours ranging from tangy pink grapefruit to rich ripe melon.
- Henri Bourgeois, Sancerre, Loire, France, 2007** 36.50
Sancerre is a fine quality Sauvignon Blanc steeped in history from the Loire valley. Richly scented exceptional gooseberry fruit from one of the best producers in the Sancerre region.
- Môreson, Premium Chardonnay, Franschoek, South Africa, 2006** 36.95
Ripe melons and citrus on the nose with undertones of wood and vanilla. The balance between the ripe fruit and fresh acidity carries the fruit nicely on the palate to ensure roundness. Our favourite Chardonnay.
- Cloudy Bay, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2008** 37.00
Ripe peach, passion fruit, mango and juicy citrus, sprinkled with fresh fennel. The palate is rich and succulent, with a zesty citrus and apple sherbet acidity that leads to a long, lingering, and very crisp finish.
- Domaine Font de Michelle, Chateauneuf du Pape, France, 2006** 49.50
A unique blend from the Rhône white grape varieties of Roussanne, Marsanne and Chasan, producing a full-bodied, rich and fragrant wine with peaches and apricots on the nose and on the palate with a touch of spice on the finish.
- Domaine Michelot, Meursault, Burgundy, France, 2004** 59.50
A Burgundy Côte de Baune Chardonnay, classic wine with orange blossom, smoky bacon, grilled brioche and nuts on the nose. A palate of wonderfully rich fruit, balanced with good acidity, clear oak and buttery. Elegant with excellent length.
- Puligny Montrachet Gerard Chavy, 2001, Burgundy, France** 68.50
Burgundy is one of finest areas in world for producing Chardonnay. Gérard Chavy produces fabulous wine from his small estate. Barrel fermentation adds flavours ranging from cream and sponge cake to orange peel with citrus freshness with great depth on the palate.

Red Wine

- Mitchell, Grenache Sangiovese-Mourvedre, Clare Valley, Western Australia, 2002** 26.95
This wine is made from hand picked grapes from some of the oldest vines in the world. It is an unusual blend producing a full-bodied, velvety, intense and heady wine full of sweet rich berry fruit and of aniseed, raspberry and cinnamon. Not for the faint hearted!
- Chapoutier, Côtes du Rhône, Organic, France, 2007** 28.50
Deep ruby in colour with a wild and earthy nose showing vibrant Syrah fruit offset by a hint of spice.

Môreson, Pinotage, South Africa, 2007	28.95
Developed especially for the South African climate, this Pinotage is dark with vibrant violet tinges and a fusion of red berry fruit. This wine shows intense cherry and raspberry flavours combining with sweet oak aromas, vanilla and cocoa.	
Volnay Boillot, Burgundy, France, 2004	58.40
A classic Pinot Noir with focused red fruit profile that is laced with some earthy truffle and a hint of spice on the finish. The wines of Lucien Boillot et Fils are not the type to take a back seat. They have been variously described as "meaty", "substantial", "tannic", "robust", "spicy" and "austere". People talk of them having a big presence on the palate.	
Domaine Font De Michelle, Chateauneuf Du Pape, Rhône, France, 2006	49.50
This classic southern Rhône blend includes Grenache Noir, Syrah and Mourvèdre. It is deep and lively, garnet in colour. This superb wine has complex and intensive aromas, predominantly blackcurrants but also notes of leather, truffles and spices. Really impressive.	
Chateau Langoa Barton, St Julien, Bordeaux, France , 1996	73.50
Langoa's 1996 vintage is superb, with expressive notes of sweet plum, red berry and bramble fruit on the nose and a creamy vanilla character. There is lovely concentration here with balancing tannins and fresh acidity.	
Mercurey, Domaine de Suremain, Burgundy, France, 2004	38.50
Silky soft Pinot Noir. Summer fruits, hints of pepper with earthy notes and a gentle touch of oak.	
Barolo, Brezza, Italy, 2001	52.50
Made from the Nebbiolo grape variety in Piedmont. This is an intensely heady, seductive wine with a surprisingly elegant nose of rosewater and almonds. The wine of kings, it is backed by bold tannins yet intense tarry fruit and hints of ripe cherries. Powerful and persistent.	
Rosé Wine	
Henri Bourgeois, Sancerre Rosé Les Jeannettes, France, 2007	36.95
A wonderful example of a Pinot Noir rosé from the Loire Valley. It is dry, elegant and delicate with scents of wild strawberries and raspberries.	
Champagne	
Bollinger Special Cuvee Brut NV	65.00
Produced with high proportion of Pinot Noir to give Bollinger its unique depth and structure, this is a great Champagne that can count James Bond among its fans.	
Dom Perignon Brut 1999	150.00
This is the vintage Prestige Champagne from the house of Moët & Chandon, which is only made in exceptionally good vintages. This is truly an opulent fine example of this world class Champagne.	
Cristal Brut 2002 (Very Limited Availability)	225.00
This is the Prestige Champagne from the house of Louis Roederer. Probably one of the finest Champagne's in the world. Great style and elegance
